

RACE ENTRY NOTES

Weston Sailing Club Open Youth Regatta

Saturday 5th – Sunday 6th September, 2009

Please read these notes before completing your entry form.

Entry Category

Full Race Class

1. Catamarans, with separate results for Hobie Dragoon and Spitfire.
2. Asymmetric Dinghies with separate results for boats with and without trapezes.
3. Fast Handicap boats with conventional spinnakers or no spinnaker, with separate results for crewed and single handed dinghies. (cut off point dependent on number of entries)
4. Slow Handicap dinghies with conventional spinnakers or no spinnaker with separate results for crewed and single handed dinghies.

Briefing on Saturday at 10.00. First race start at 11.00
Up to 4 races scheduled per day

Parent and Child

Any boat sailed by one adult and one or more children. The adult does not have to be a parent of the children but the aim is to allow less experienced children and children who do not own a Junior or Youth boat the opportunity to sail in the event.
There will be separate prizes for the first boat helmed by a parent and the first boat helmed by a child. It is expected that Youth Sailors over 12 will helm their entry unless they are novices with less than two years sailing experience.
Crew may be changed between races.

Up to 3 races scheduled per day

Novice

Open to any competitor with less than two years sailing experience, who wants to sail on a short course. Crew may be changed between races. All races will start and finish near the club.

Up to 3 races scheduled per day

Non Racing

Open to Weston Junior sailors that have not yet reached RYA Level 2 or who do not want to race. The club will provide supervised sailing and games with shared use of club boats.

Club Boats

Members of Weston Sailing Club wanting to use a club boat should indicate by putting 'club Pico, club Laser or club Feva as the class of boat and pay the additional fee. There are a limited number of boats available on a first come basis. Please contact the administrator to find availability.

Team Competition

All competitors will be formed into teams by the event organisers. Teams will consist of 2 or 3 boats from each class to represent different clubs. Competitors may nominate who they would like in their team although team places can not be guaranteed.
